## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 10, 2015 (P.L.148, No.29), entitled "An act designating the Conodoguinet Bridge on that portion of 2 State Route 641 over the Conodoguinet Creek, Hopewell Township, Cumberland County, as the Army Pfc. Harold 'Sam' E. 3 4 Barrick Memorial Bridge; designating the bridge located on that portion of State Route 865, over the railroad tracks and Main Street in Bellwood, Blair County, as the Dominec M. 7 'Patsy' Padula Memorial Bridge; designating the bridge on 8 that portion of State Route 940 over Tobyhanna Creek (Pocono 9 Lake) in Tobyhanna Township, Monroe County, as the Sullivan 10 Bridge; designating a bridge on that portion of State Route 11 155 over the Allegheny River, Port Allegany Borough and 12 Liberty Township, McKean County, as the Port Allegany Veterans Memorial Bridge; designating a bridge on that 13 14 portion of Local Route T-325 over the Allegheny River, 15 Coudersport Borough, Potter County, as the Lt. William E. 16 17 Daisley, Jr., Memorial Bridge; designating the bridge on that portion of State Route 3005 over the outlet of Lily Lake, 18 Conyngham Township, Luzerne County, as the Senior Officer 19 20 Eric J. Williams Memorial Bridge; designating the bridge on that portion of State Route 3005 over the West Branch of the 21 Susquehanna River, Greenwood Township, Clearfield County, as 22 the 1st Lieutenant Wendell Elbert Ross Memorial Bridge; 23 designating a bridge on that portion of State Route 3007 over 24 25 the Redbank Creek, Summerville Borough, Jefferson County, as the Summerville Veterans Memorial Bridge; and renaming the 26 27 bridge on that portion of U.S. Route 219 over U.S. Route 422 in Ebensburg Borough, Cambria County, as the Alexander Miller 28 Abercrombie Memorial Bridge," further providing for the 29 Dominec M. "Patsy" Padula Memorial Bridge. 30

- 19 designating the bridge on that portion of State Route 3005 over
- 20 the outlet of Lily Lake, Conyngham Township, Luzerne County, as

- 22 the bridge on that portion of State Route 3005 over the West
- 23 Branch of the Susquehanna River, Greenwood Township, Clearfield
- 24 County, as the 1st Lieutenant Wendell Elbert Ross Memorial
- 25 Bridge; designating a bridge on that portion of State Route 3007
- 26 over the Redbank Creek, Summerville Borough, Jefferson County,
- 27 as the Summerville Veterans Memorial Bridge; and renaming the
- 28 bridge on that portion of U.S. Route 219 over U.S. Route 422 in
- 29 Ebensburg Borough, Cambria County, as the Alexander Miller
- 30 Abercrombie Memorial Bridge," is amended to read:

- 1 Section 2. Dominec M. "Patsy" Padula Memorial Bridge.
- 2 (a) Findings and declarations. -- The General Assembly finds
- 3 and declares as follows:

- 6 during the following World War II campaigns:
- 7 (i) Normandy, Omaha Beach.
- 8 (ii) Northern France.
- 9 (iii) Rhineland.

- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
