AN ACT

1 Amending the act of July 10, 2015 (P.L.148, No.29), entitled "An
 2 act designating the Conodoguinet Bridge on that portion of
 3 State Route 641 over the Conodoguinet Creek, Hopewell
 4 Township, Cumberland County, as the Army Pfc. Harold 'Sam' E.
 5 Barrick Memorial Bridge; designating the bridge located on
 6 that portion of State Route 865, over the railroad tracks and
 7 Main Street in Bellwood, Blair County, as the Dominec M.
 8 'Patsy' Padula Memorial Bridge; designating the bridge on
 9 that portion of State Route 940 over Tobyhanna Creek (Pocono
 10 Lake) in Tobyhanna Township, Monroe County, as the Sullivan
 11 Bridge; designating a bridge on that portion of State Route
 12 155 over the Allegheny River, Port Allegany Borough and
 13 Liberty Township, McKean County, as the Port Allegany
 14 Veterans Memorial Bridge; designating a bridge on that
 15 portion of Local Route T-325 over the Allegheny River,
 16 Coudersport Borough, Potter County, as the Lt. William E.
 17 Daisley, Jr., Memorial Bridge; designating the bridge on that
 18 portion of State Route 3005 over the outlet of Lily Lake,
 19 Conyngham Township, Luzerne County, as the Senior Officer
 20 Eric J. Williams Memorial Bridge; designating the bridge on
 21 that portion of State Route 3005 over the West Branch of the
 22 Susquehanna River, Greenwood Township, Clearfield County, as
 23 the 1st Lieutenant Wendell Elbert Ross Memorial Bridge;
 24 designating a bridge on that portion of State Route 3007 over
 25 the Redbank Creek, Summerville Borough, Jefferson County, as
 26 the Summerville Veterans Memorial Bridge; and renaming the
 27 bridge on that portion of U.S. Route 219 over U.S. Route 422
 28 in Ebensburg Borough, Cambria County, as the Alexander Miller
 29 Abercrombie Memorial Bridge," further providing for the
 30 Dominec M. "Patsy" Padula Memorial Bridge.

1 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

2 hereby enacts as follows:

3 Section 1. Section 2(a) of the act of July 10, 2015

4 (P.L.148, No.29), entitled "An act designating the Conodoguinet

5 Bridge on that portion of State Route 641 over the Conodoguinet

6 Creek, Hopewell Township, Cumberland County, as the Army Pfc.

7 Harold 'Sam' E. Barrick Memorial Bridge; designating the bridge

8 located on that portion of State Route 865, over the railroad

9 tracks and Main Street in Bellwood, Blair County, as the Dominec

10 M. 'Patsy' Padula Memorial Bridge; designating the bridge on

11 that portion of State Route 940 over Tobyhanna Creek (Pocono

12 Lake) in Tobyhanna Township, Monroe County, as the Sullivan

13 Bridge; designating a bridge on that portion of State Route 155

14 over the Allegheny River, Port Allegany Borough and Liberty

15 Township, McKean County, as the Port Allegany Veterans Memorial

16 Bridge; designating a bridge on that portion of Local Route T-

17 325 over the Allegheny River, Coudersport Borough, Potter

18 County, as the Lt. William E. Daisley, Jr., Memorial Bridge;

19 designating the bridge on that portion of State Route 3005 over

20 the outlet of Lily Lake, Conyngham Township, Luzerne County, as

21 the Senior Officer Eric J. Williams Memorial Bridge; designating

22 the bridge on that portion of State Route 3005 over the West

23 Branch of the Susquehanna River, Greenwood Township, Clearfield

24 County, as the 1st Lieutenant Wendell Elbert Ross Memorial

25 Bridge; designating a bridge on that portion of State Route 3007

26 over the Redbank Creek, Summerville Borough, Jefferson County,

27 as the Summerville Veterans Memorial Bridge; and renaming the

28 bridge on that portion of U.S. Route 219 over U.S. Route 422 in

29 Ebensburg Borough, Cambria County, as the Alexander Miller

30 Abercrombie Memorial Bridge," is amended to read:

1 Section 2. Dominec M. "Patsy" Padula Memorial Bridge.

2 (a) Findings and declarations.--The General Assembly finds
3 and declares as follows:

5 (3) Dominec Padula received five Bronze Service Stars
6 during the following World War II campaigns:

7 (i) Normandy, Omaha Beach.

8 (ii) Northern France.

9 (iii) Rhineland.

10 (iv) Ardennes, Battle of the Bulge.

11 (v) Central Europe.

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
