AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in Commonwealth services, providing for firefighting protective equipment.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 35 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	§ 7390. Firefighting protective equipment.
9	(a) Warning labels
10	(1) A manufacturer that produces or sells personal
11	protective equipment for firefighting entities in this
12	Commonwealth containing PFAS chemicals shall affix a warning
13	label to the product that indicates that the product contains
14	perfluorooctane (PFOS) or perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA) and
15	provide a written notice to the purchaser at the time of the
16	<pre>sale that includes:</pre>

(i) A statement that the personal protective

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- 1 <u>equipment contains PFAS chemicals.</u>
- 2 (ii) The reason that the personal protective
- 3 equipment contains PFAS chemicals.
- 4 (2) The manufacturer and purchaser of the personal
- 5 protective equipment containing perfluorooctane (PFOS) or
- 6 perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA) shall retain the written notice
- 7 <u>under this section on file for at least three years from the</u>
- 8 <u>date of purchase.</u>
- 9 <u>(b) Enforcement.--The Office of the State Fire Commissioner</u>
- 10 shall enforce the provisions of this section.
- 11 <u>(c) Violations.--</u>
- 12 (1) A manufacturer or person shall be subject to a civil
- penalty not to exceed \$5,000 for a first violation and
- \$10,000 for each subsequent violation.
- 15 (2) Money collected under paragraph (1) shall be
- transferred to the department for the Fire Company Grant
- 17 Program and the Emergency Medical Services Grant Program.
- 18 (d) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 19 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 20 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 21 "Firefighting entity." An entity that engages in fire
- 22 prevention, firefighting or fire control activities in this
- 23 Commonwealth. The term shall include municipal fire departments
- 24 and volunteer fire companies.
- 25 "Manufacturer." A person that manufactures, imports or
- 26 distributes domestically personal protective equipment for a
- 27 <u>firefighting entity.</u>
- 28 "Personal protective equipment." Items designed, intended or
- 29 <u>marketed to be worn by firefighting entity personnel in the</u>
- 30 performance of fire and rescue activities, including jackets,

- 1 pants, shoes, gloves, helmets and respiratory equipment.
- 2 "PFAS chemical." A fluorinated organic chemical that
- 3 <u>contains at least one fully fluorinated carbon atom and is</u>
- 4 <u>designed to be fully functional in formulations of class B</u>
- 5 <u>firefighting foam.</u>
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
