12	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
13	hereby enacts as follows:
14	Section 1. Section 13 of the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242,
15	No.86), referred to as the Cosmetology Law, is amended by adding
16	a subsection to read:
17	Section 13. Powers and Duties of Board* * *
18	(d) The board shall appoint inspectors whose title shall be
19	"Inspector, State Board of Cosmetology, Commonwealth of
20	Pennsylvania." Each inspector shall be a licensed cosmetologist
21	who has been actively engaged in the practice of cosmetology for
22	at least five years. Each inspector shall hold office at the
23	pleasure of the board and shall receive compensation as fixed by

- 1 the board with the approval of the department. Each inspector
- 2 shall have the right of entry into any place where the business
- 3 or profession of cosmetology is carried out for the purpose of
- 4 inspection and for the investigation of complaints before the
- 5 board and for other matters as the board may direct.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
