AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An
- act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public
- welfare laws of the Commonwealth," in public assistance,
- 4 providing for medical assistance coverage for doula services.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known
- 8 as the Human Services Code, is amended by adding a section to
- 9 read:
- 10 Section 443.15. Medical Assistance Coverage for Doula
- 11 Services. -- (a) Subject to Federal approval, doula services are
- 12 <u>compensable under the medical assistance program for eligible</u>
- 13 and enrolled medical assistance recipients during pregnancy,
- 14 <u>labor and delivery and up to one year postpartum.</u>
- 15 (b) The department shall establish a Doula Advisory Board to
- 16 advise the secretary regarding the following:
- 17 (1) Doula best practices.

- 1 (2) Doula participation in the medical assistance program.
- 2 (3) Racial and geographic disparities in the provision of
- 3 maternal health services.
- 4 (4) Equity and inclusion best practices.
- 5 (c) The Doula Advisory Board shall include the following:
- 6 (1) The secretary.
- 7 (2) A representative from the Department of State.
- 8 (3) A representative from the Office of Medical Assistance
- 9 Programs within the department.
- 10 (4) A representative from the Bureau of Family Health within
- 11 <u>the Department of Health.</u>
- 12 (5) A representative from the Office of Health Equity within
- 13 <u>the Department of Health.</u>
- 14 (6) A representative from a nationally recognized doula
- 15 organization.
- 16 (7) A doula practicing in this Commonwealth.
- 17 (8) A member of the Maternal Mortality Review Committee
- 18 established under the act of May 9, 2018 (P.L.118, No.24), known
- 19 as the Maternal Mortality Review Act.
- 20 (9) A member of a commission that supports doula practice in
- 21 Pennsylvania.
- 22 (10) As deemed appropriate by the department, any other
- 23 <u>residents of this Commonwealth who represent the diverse</u>
- 24 demographics of Pennsylvania.
- 25 (d) The department shall seek a State plan amendment or
- 26 Federal waiver from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid
- 27 <u>Services, if needed, for provision of doula services under the</u>
- 28 medical assistance program.
- (e) As used in this section, the term "doula" shall mean a
- 30 professional trained to provide physical, emotional and

- 1 <u>informational support to a pregnant individual MOTHER before</u>,
- 2 during and after childbirth.
- 3 Section 2. If a necessary State plan amendment or Federal
- 4 waiver under section 443.15 of the act is approved by the
- 5 Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, the Secretary of
- 6 Human Services shall transmit notice of the approval to the
- 7 Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the next
- 8 available issue of the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
- 9 Section 3. This act shall take effect as follows:
- 10 (1) Except as provided under paragraph (2), the addition
- of section 443.15 of the act shall take effect 30 days
- following publication of the notice under section 2 of this
- 13 act.
- 14 (2) The addition of section 443.15(b) and (c) of the act
- shall take effect immediately.
- 16 (3) The remainder of this act shall take effect
- immediately.
