- Section 1. Section 4305 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- § 4305. Dealing in infant children.
- (a) Offense defined. -- A person is guilty of a [misdemeanor] 10
- 11 felony of the first degree if he deals in humanity, by trading,
- bartering, buying, selling, or dealing in infant children. 12
- 13 (b) EXCLUSION.--THIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO AN OTHERWISE <--
- 14 LEGAL SURROGACY OR ADOPTION.
- (C) Definitions.--As used in this section, the term "infant 15
- 16 child" means a child one year of age or younger.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
