AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), entitled, 1 as amended, "An act relating to the finances of the State 2 government; providing for cancer control, prevention and 3 research, for ambulatory surgical center data collection, for the Joint Underwriting Association, for entertainment 5 business financial management firms, for private dam 6 financial assurance and for reinstatement of item vetoes; providing for the settlement, assessment, collection, and 8 lien of taxes, bonus, and all other accounts due the 9 Commonwealth, the collection and recovery of fees and other 10 money or property due or belonging to the Commonwealth, or 11 any agency thereof, including escheated property and the 12 proceeds of its sale, the custody and disbursement or other 13 disposition of funds and securities belonging to or in the 14 possession of the Commonwealth, and the settlement of claims 15 against the Commonwealth, the resettlement of accounts and 16 17 appeals to the courts, refunds of moneys erroneously paid to the Commonwealth, auditing the accounts of the Commonwealth 18 19 and all agencies thereof, of all public officers collecting moneys payable to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 20 and all receipts of appropriations from the Commonwealth, 21 22 authorizing the Commonwealth to issue tax anticipation notes 23 to defray current expenses, implementing the provisions of section 7(a) of Article VIII of the Constitution of 24 Pennsylvania authorizing and restricting the incurring of 25 certain debt and imposing penalties; affecting every 26 department, board, commission, and officer of the State 27 government, every political subdivision of the State, and 28 29 certain officers of such subdivisions, every person, 30 association, and corporation required to pay, assess, or collect taxes, or to make returns or reports under the laws 31 imposing taxes for State purposes, or to pay license fees or 32 other moneys to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 33

- Commonwealth," in general budget implementation, further providing for State Gaming Fund. 2

- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. Section 1799-E(a) of the act of April 9, 1929 6
- (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, is amended to read: 7
- Section 1799-E. State Gaming Fund. 8
- Transfers for Volunteer Fire Company and Volunteer 9 (a)
- 10 Ambulance Service Grant Act. -- Commencing with fiscal year 2007-
- 11 2008 and continuing annually thereafter, the sum of
- [\$25,000,000] <u>\$33,750,000</u> shall be transferred from the State 12
- Gaming Fund to the General Fund and is hereby appropriated on a 13
- continuing basis to the [Pennsylvania Emergency Management 14
- 15 Agency] Office of the State Fire Commissioner for the purpose of
- making grants under 35 Pa.C.S. Ch. 78 (relating to grants to 16
- volunteer fire companies and volunteer services). Annually, the 17
- sum of [\$22,000,000] \$27,000,000 shall be expended for the 18
- 19 purpose of making grants to eligible volunteer fire companies
- 20 under 35 Pa.C.S. Ch. 78 Subch. B (relating to volunteer fire
- 21 company grant program). Annually, the sum of [\$3,000,000]
- \$6,750,000 shall be expended for the purpose of making grants to 22
- eligible volunteer ambulance services under 35 Pa.C.S. Ch. 78 23
