## AN ACT

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions 2 relating to civil actions and proceedings, further providing 3 for comparative negligence. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 7102(a.1)(3) and (d) of Title 42 of the 7 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 9 § 7102. Comparative negligence. \* \* \* 10 11 (a.1) Recovery against joint defendant; contribution .--12 A defendant's liability in any of the following 13 14 actions shall be joint and several, and the court shall enter 15 a joint and several judgment in favor of the plaintiff and 16 against the defendant for the total dollar amount awarded as 17 damages: 18 (i) Intentional misrepresentation.

(ii) An intentional tort.

- 1 (iii) Where the defendant has been held liable for 2 not less than 60% of the total liability apportioned to 3 all parties.
- 4 (iv) A release or threatened release of a hazardous 5 substance under section 702 of the act of October 18, 6 1988 (P.L.756, No.108), known as the Hazardous Sites 7 Cleanup Act.
- 8 (v) A civil action in which a defendant has violated 9 section 497 of the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), 10 known as the Liquor Code.
- 11 (vi) In a case where a minor has a beneficial

- 14 (d) Definitions.--As used in this section the following
  15 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 16 subsection:
- "Defendant or defendants." Includes impleaded defendants.
- 18 "Minor." An individual under 18 years of age.
- "Off-road vehicle." A motorized vehicle that is used off-
- 20 road for sport or recreation. The term includes snowmobiles,
- 21 all-terrain vehicles, motorcycles and four-wheel drive vehicles.
- "Off-road vehicle riding area." Any area or facility
- 23 providing recreational activities for off-road vehicles.
- 24 "Off-road vehicle riding area operator." A person or
- 25 organization owning or having operational responsibility for any
- 26 off-road vehicle riding area. The term includes:
- 27 (1) Agencies and political subdivisions of this 28 Commonwealth.
- 29 (2) Authorities created by political subdivisions.
- 30 (3) Private companies.

- 1 "Plaintiff." Includes counter claimants and cross-claimants.
- 2 Section 2. The amendment of 42 Pa.C.S. § 7102 shall apply to
- 3 causes of action which accrue on or after the effective date of
- 4 this section.
- 5 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
