- 5 <u>licensed to train therapy dogs from aiding and guiding an</u>
- 6 <u>individual with a disability or from riding on a vehicle</u>
- 7 <u>operated for public transportation.</u>
- 8 (3) Charge a fee for the transportation of a therapy
- 9 <u>dog.</u>
- 10 (b) Rules and regulations. -- The department shall promulgate
- 11 rules and regulations necessary to implement this subchapter.
- (c) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 13 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 14 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 15 "Public transportation authority." The term shall have the
- 16 <u>same meaning as "authority" as defined in 74 Pa.C.S. § 1701</u>
- 17 (relating to definitions).
- 18 "Recognized therapy dog training organization." An
- 19 organization that certifies or registers therapy dogs and
- 20 <u>therapy dog handlers</u>.
- 21 "Therapy dog." A dog that is trained to work or perform
- 22 specific tasks for the benefit of individuals, including those
- 23 with special needs, autism, drug addiction, distress due to
- 24 emotional and physical abuse and clinical depression or bipolar
- 25 disorder by a recognized therapy dog training organization and
- 26 is used for that purpose.
- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
