Information in central repository or automated systems. * * * 10 11 (c) Dissemination of protected information. --12 13 Investigative and treatment information shall not be 14 disseminated to any department, agency or individual unless 15 the department, agency or individual requesting the 16 information is a criminal justice agency which requests the 17 information in connection with its duties, and the request is 18 based upon a name, fingerprints, modus operandi, genetic 19 typing, voice print or other identifying characteristic. Justice shall evaluate investigative and treatment information pertaining to potential or prospective risk to public health. If the Office of Environmental Justice determines that a potential or prospective public health risk exists, the Office of Environmental Justice shall publish a notice, including a summary of the public health risk on its publicly accessible Internet website.

The Office of Environmental Justice may not publish the notice of the public health risk if the notice would compromise an investigation.
