## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for special plates for recipients of Navy and Marine Corps Medal.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	§ 1366.2. Special plates for recipients of Navy and Marine
9	<u>Corps Medal.</u>
10	Upon application of any person who is a recipient of the Navy
11	and Marine Corps Medal, accompanied by a fee of <del>\$20</del> \$22 which <
12	shall be in addition to the registration fee and by such
13	documentation as the department shall require, the department
14	shall issue to the person a special registration plate
15	designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who
16	is a recipient of the Navy and Marine Corps Medal. The special

- 1 registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck
- 2 with a registered gross weight of not more than 14,000 pounds.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in <del>60</del> 120 days. <--
