A JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth 1 of Pennsylvania, reducing the size of the General Assembly. 2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 3 hereby resolves as follows: 4 5 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI: 6 7 That section 16 of Article II be amended to read: 8 § 16. Legislative districts. 9 The Commonwealth shall be divided into [50] 38 senatorial and 203 representative districts, which shall be composed of compact 10 11 and contiguous territory as nearly equal in population as 12 practicable. Each senatorial district shall elect one Senator, 13 and each representative district one Representative. Unless absolutely necessary no county, city, incorporated town, 14

borough, township or ward shall be divided in forming either a
senatorial or representative district.

3 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the 4 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to 5 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article 6 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the 7 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in 8 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after 9 10 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.

11 Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this (b) 12 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the 13 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 14 15 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required 16 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such 17 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of 18 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the 19 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment 20 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first 21 primary, general or municipal election which meets the 22 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least 23 24 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is 25 passed by the General Assembly.

Section 3. Upon ratification by the electors, the General Assembly shall enact legislation to implement this constitutional amendment so that it applies for the first time to the first session of the General Assembly which begins after the 2020 reapportionment.

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
