- 3 (a) Establishment.--The Pennsylvania Census Commission is
- 4 established within the Joint State Government Commission.
- 5 (b) Membership. -- The commission shall be comprised of the
- 6 <u>following members:</u>
- 7 <u>(1) The Governor or a designee.</u>
- 8 (2) The Secretary of Agriculture or a designee.
- 9 <u>(3) The Secretary of Community and Economic Development</u>
- 10 or a designee.
- 11 (4) The Secretary of Corrections or a designee.
- 12 <u>(5) The Secretary of Human Services or a designee.</u>
- 13 (6) The Secretary of Labor and Industry or a designee.
- 14 <u>(7) The President pro tempore of the Senate or a</u>
- 15 <u>designee</u>.
- 16 (8) The Minority Leader of the Senate or a designee.
- 17 (9) The Speaker of the House of Representatives or a
- 18 <u>designee</u>.
- 19 (10) The Minority Leader of the House of Representatives
- 20 <u>or a designee</u>.
- 21 (11) Eleven other members appointed by the Governor and
- 22 confirmed by the Senate which shall include members who:
- 23 <u>(i) Represent a rural community.</u>
- 24 (ii) Represent an urban community.
- 25 <u>(iii) Represent a suburban community.</u>
- 26 (iv) Represent the following regions of this
- 27 <u>Commonwealth:</u>
- (A) The northeastern region.

3	(c) Duties The commission shall have the following duties:
4	(1) Advise the Governor and the General Assembly on
5	census activities within the Commonwealth.
6	(2) Identify barriers that might impede the progress of
7	future Federal decennial censuses in this Commonwealth.
8	(3) Promote and advertise future Federal decennial
9	censuses.
10	(4) Respond to residents' questions and concerns about a
11	census.
12	(5) Develop partnerships with regional and local
13	Complete Count Committees to increase participation in the
14	census.
15	(6) Distribute and share census information with
16	traditionally hard-to-count areas and populations.
17	(7) Seek to ensure the highest census participation rate
18	possible.
19	(8) Gather information and produce reports under section
20	4303 (relating to report on census activities).
21	(d) Quorum A majority of appointed members shall
22	constitute a quorum for the purpose of conducting business.
23	(e) Chairperson and vice chairperson The members shall
24	select a chairperson and vice chairperson from among the
25	membership of the board.
26	(f) Transparency and ethics The commission shall be
27	subject to the following laws:
28	(1) The act of July 19, 1957 (P.L.1017, No.451), known
29	as the State Adverse Interest Act.
30	(2) The act of February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), known as

- 1 the Right-to-Know Law.
- 2 (3) 65 Pa.C.S. Ch. 7 (relating to open meetings).
- 3 (g) Information gathering. -- The commission shall use data
- 4 from the Pennsylvania State Data Center and may conduct hearings
- 5 <u>and otherwise gather additional relevant information and</u>
- 6 analysis that the commission considers appropriate and
- 7 necessary.
- 8 (h) Reimbursement. -- Members of the commission shall be
- 9 reimbursed for reasonable expenses.
- 10 § 4303. Report on census activities.
- 11 (a) Annual report. -- The commission shall gather and issue an
- 12 <u>annual report on the commission's findings by December 1 of each</u>
- 13 <u>year.</u>
- 14 (b) Additional reports.--In addition to the commission's
- 15 <u>annual report, the commission shall gather and issue the</u>
- 16 <u>following reports:</u>
- 17 (1) Previous Federal decennial census activities and
- 18 results by January 1 or 48 months prior to the start of a
- 19 future Federal decennial census year.
- 20 (2) A preliminary plan for a future Federal decennial
- 21 <u>census by January 1 or 36 months prior to the start of a</u>
- 22 <u>future Federal decennial census year.</u>
- 23 (3) A final plan for a future Federal decennial census
- by July 1 or 36 months prior to the start of a future Federal
- decennial census year.
- 26 (4) An implementation plan for a future Federal
- 27 <u>decennial census by January 1 or 24 months prior to the start</u>
- of a future Federal decennial census year.
- 29 <u>(5) Funding recommendation plan for a future Federal</u>
- decennial census by July 1 or 24 months prior to the start of

- 1 a future Federal decennial census year.
- 2 (c) Submission of reports. -- The reports under this section
- 3 shall be reported to:
- 4 (1) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
- 5 Appropriations Committee of the Senate.
- 6 (2) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
- 7 Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 8 <u>(3) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the</u>
- 9 <u>State Government Committee of the Senate.</u>
- 10 (4) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
- 11 <u>State Government Committee of the House of Representatives.</u>
- 12 (d) Reports made publicly available. -- A copy of all reports
- 13 <u>under this section shall be made publicly available by being</u>
- 14 posted on the Joint State Government Commission's publicly
- 15 accessible Internet website.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
