AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in municipal authorities, further
- providing for exemption from taxation and payments in lieu of
- 4 taxes.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 5620 of Title 53 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 9 § 5620. Exemption from taxation and payments in lieu of taxes.
- 10 (a) General rule. -- The effectuation of the authorized
- 11 purposes of authorities created under this chapter shall be for
- 12 the benefit of the people of this Commonwealth, for the increase
- 13 of their commerce and prosperity and for the improvement of
- 14 their health and living conditions. Since authorities will be
- 15 performing essential governmental functions in effectuating
- 16 these purposes, authorities shall not be required to pay taxes
- 17 or assessments upon property acquired or used by them for such
- 18 purposes[.], except as otherwise provided in subsection (c).
- 19 (b) Water service. -- Whenever in excess of 10% of the land

- 1 area of any political subdivision in a sixth, seventh or eighth
- 2 class county has been taken for a waterworks, water supply works
- 3 or water distribution system having a source of water within a
- 4 political subdivision which is not provided with water service
- 5 by the authority, in lieu of such taxes or special assessments
- 6 the authority may agree to make payments in the county to the
- 7 taxing authorities of any or all of the political subdivisions
- 8 where any land has been taken.
- 9 (c) Watershed management. -- Whenever an authority located in
- 10 <u>a third class home rule county that owns property in a sixth</u>
- 11 class county for purposes of watershed management begins
- 12 <u>development on the property, the authority shall immediately</u>
- 13 begin paying all applicable taxes on all parcels of land the
- 14 authority owns in the sixth class county at the most recent fair
- 15 market value.
- 16 (d) State taxation. -- The bonds issued by any authority,
- 17 their transfer and the income from the bonds, including any
- 18 profits made on their sale, shall be free from taxation within
- 19 the Commonwealth.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
