Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in municipal authorities, further providing for purposes and powers. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 5607(b)(4) of Title 53 of the 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 8 § 5607. Purposes and powers. * * * 9 (b) Limitations. -- This section is subject to the following 10 11 limitations: * * * 12 1.3 (4) An authority located in a third class home rule 14 county that owns property in a sixth class county for 15 purposes of watershed management under section 5615 (relating to acquisition of lands, water and rights) may not develop 16 the property without approval of the residents of the 17 18 municipality in which the watershed is located and which

- 1 approval must be granted through a referendum. At the request
- of the authority, the municipal government shall place a
- 3 <u>ballot question on the next general election. The question</u>
- 4 <u>shall read: Are you in favor of (insert authority name here)</u>
- 5 <u>developing the watershed property they own located in (insert</u>
- 6 <u>name of municipal body) for the purpose of (explanation of</u>
- 7 project). If the referendum is approved, the authority may
- 8 proceed with the project. If the referendum fails, the
- 9 authority may not proceed with the project and may not
- 10 request a ballot initiative again on the matter for five
- 11 <u>years.</u>

- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
