## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in dissemination of criminal history record information, further providing for fees for background checks.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section $9121(\mathrm{~b})(1)$ of Title 18 of the
Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
§ 9121. General regulations.

*     *         * 

(b) Dissemination to noncriminal justice agencies and individuals.--Criminal history record information shall be disseminated by a state or local police department to any individual or noncriminal justice agency only upon request. Except as provided in subsection (b.1):
(1) A fee may be charged by a State or local police department for each request for criminal history record
information by an individual or noncriminal justice agency, except that no fee shall be charged to an individual who makes the request in order to [apply] do any of the following:
(i) Apply to become a volunteer with an affiliate of Big Brothers of America or Big Sisters of America or with a rape crisis center or domestic violence program.
(ii) Apply to become, or to remain in his or her position as, a volunteer firefighter, as defined in 35 Pa.C.S. § 7412 (relating to definitions) or an emergency medical services provider, as defined in 35 Pa.C.S. § 8103 (relating to definitions). * * *

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
