14	(1) Police departments shall, upon request, furnish a
15	certified copy of the full report of the police investigation
16	of any vehicle accident to any [person involved in the
17	accident, his attorney or insurer, and to the Federal
18	Government, branches of the military service, Commonwealth
19	agencies, and to officials of political subdivisions and to
20	agencies of other states and nations and their political
21	subdivisions.] of the following:
22	(i) A person involved in the accident and the
23	person's attorney or insurer.
24	(ii) The Federal Government.
25	(iii) Branches of the military service.
26	(iv) Commonwealth agencies.
27	(v) Officials of political subdivisions.

5	(6) NOTHING UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO <
6	PROHIBIT A LOCAL POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM WAIVING THE COST FOR
7	A VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY OR A VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE COMPANY
8	THAT REQUESTS A COPY OF A REPORT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION FOR
9	INSURANCE BILLING PURPOSES.
10	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
