## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in burglary and other criminal 2 intrusion, further providing for the offense of criminal 3 4 trespass. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 3503(b)(1) of Title 18 of the 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 9 § 3503. Criminal trespass. 10 11 (b) Defiant trespasser. --A person commits an offense if, knowing that he is 12 13 not licensed or privileged to do so, he enters or remains in 14 any place as to which notice against trespass is given by: 15 actual communication to the actor; (i) 16 (ii) posting in a manner prescribed by law or 17 reasonably likely to come to the attention of intruders;

2	to exclude intruders;
3	(iv) notices posted in a manner prescribed by law or
4	reasonably likely to come to the person's attention at
5	each entrance of school grounds that visitors are
6	prohibited without authorization from a designated
7	school, center or program official; [or]
8	(v) an actual communication to the actor to leave
9	school grounds as communicated by a school, center or
10	program official, employee or agent or a law enforcement
11	officer[.]; or
12	(vi) vertical lines, using industry standard no <
13	hunting purple paint at least eight inches long and one
14	inch wide and between three and five feet above the
15	ground on trees or posts around the property. The paint
16	marks may not be more than 100 feet apart from the next
17	closest paint mark and shall be placed so that the paint
18	marks are readily visible to a person approaching the
19	property.
20	(VI) THE PLACEMENT OF IDENTIFYING PURPLE PAINT MARKS <
21	ON TREES OR POSTS ON THE PROPERTY WHICH ARE:
22	(A) VERTICAL LINES OF NOT LESS THAN EIGHT INCHES
23	IN LENGTH AND NOT LESS THAN ONE INCH IN WIDTH;
24	(B) PLACED SO THAT THE BOTTOM OF THE MARK IS NOT
25	LESS THAN THREE FEET FROM THE GROUND NOR MORE THAN
26	FIVE FEET FROM THE GROUND; AND
27	(C) PLACED AT LOCATIONS THAT ARE READILY VISIBLE
28	TO A PERSON APPROACHING THE PROPERTY AND NO MORE THAN
29	100 FEET APART.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
