## AN ACT

1 2 3 4	Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in availability of otherwise confidential information, providing for reports on domestic violence by law enforcement agencies.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	<u>§ 8726. Reports on domestic violence by law enforcement</u>
10	agencies.
11	(a) Furnishing copies of reportsNotwithstanding any other
12	provision of law, a law enforcement agency shall, upon request,
13	furnish a copy of a report on a criminal investigation into an
14	allegation of a domestic violence incident to any of the
15	following:
16	(1) A victim of the incident or the victim's attorney.
17	(2) An official from any of the following government
18	entities if necessary to protect a victim of domestic abuse:

1 <u>(i) The Federal Government.</u>		
2 (ii) A branch of the United States Armed Forces.		
3 <u>(iii) A Commonwealth agency.</u>		
4 (iv) A political subdivision in this Commonwealth.		
5 <u>(v) An out-of-State government agency or political</u>		
6 <u>subdivision.</u>		
7 (b) CostsThe following apply:		
8 (1) Except as provided under paragraphs (2) and (3), the		
9 <u>cost of furnishing a copy of the report under subsection (a)</u>		
10 to an individual specified under subsection (a)(1) shall be		
11 <u>\$25.</u>		
12 (2) If the individual requesting a copy of the report		
13 <u>under subsection (a) is a party to a judicial proceeding</u>		
14 relating to the domestic violence incident and has been		
15 granted approval to proceed in forma pauperis, the cost of		
16 <u>furnishing a copy of the report under subsection (a) shall be</u>		
17 <u>\$0.</u>		
18 (3) If the individual requesting a copy of the report		
19 <u>under subsection (a) demonstrates to the law enforcement</u>		
20 agency that the individual is receiving services free-of-		
21 charge from a nonprofit organization dedicated to helping		
22 domestic violence victims, the cost of furnishing a copy of		
23 the report under subsection (a) shall be \$0.		
24 (c) InadmissibleA copy of the report under subsection (a)		
25 shall be inadmissible in any civil or criminal proceeding		
26 arising out of the domestic violence incident.		
27 (d) Refusal to furnishA law enforcement agency may refuse		
28 to furnish a copy of the report under subsection (a) regarding a		
29 domestic violence incident if there are criminal charges pending		
30 against an individual involved in the domestic violence		
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1	incident, unless necessary to comply with the Pennsylvania Rules
2	of Criminal Procedure or Federal law.
3	(e) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
4	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
5	subsection:
6	"Domestic violence." An act of violence that constitutes a
7	crime as specified under 18 Pa.C.S. (relating to crimes and
8	offenses) if any of the following apply:
9	(1) The alleged perpetrator of the violence and the
10	victim are family or household members as defined in 23
11	<u>Pa.C.S. § 6102 (relating to definitions).</u>
12	(2) The alleged perpetrator of the violence and the
13	victim temporarily or permanently reside in the same
14	dwelling.
15	"Law enforcement agency." A police department of a city,
16	borough, incorporated town or township, the Pennsylvania State
17	Police, district attorneys' offices and the Office of Attorney
18	<u>General.</u>
19	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
