## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6	Amending the act of June 30, 2011 (P.L.81, No.18), entitled "An act providing for the establishment of a searchable budget database-driven Internet website detailing certain information concerning taxpayer expenditures and investments," further providing for searchable budget database and for administration.
7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Section 3(g) of the act of June 30, 2011 (P.L.81,
10	No.18), known as the Pennsylvania Web Accountability and
11	Transparency (PennWATCH) Act, is amended and the section is
12	amended by adding a subsection to read:
13	Section 3. Searchable budget database.

15	(f.1) Settlements
16	(1) The website shall include information on each
17	settlement paid to an employee of a Commonwealth agency or
18	<u>paid to an individual as a result of an action taken by an</u>

1	<u>employee of a Commonwealth agency for each claim under the</u>
2	Employee Liability Self-Insurance Program (ELSIP), the
3	Automobile Liability Self-Insurance Program (ALSIP), the
4	Motor License Tort Claim Fund (MLTF), notary bonds and the
5	General Tort Claims Self-Insurance Fund. The information
6	shall include all of the following:
7	(i) The Commonwealth agency that is the subject of
8	the claim.
9	(ii) The date when the claim was filed.
10	(iii) The type of complaint filed.
11	(iv) The date when the settlement was paid.
12	(v) The amount of the settlement.
13	(2) No later than 30 days after the date when a
14	settlement was paid, the website shall post the information
15	under paragraph (1).
16	(3) No later than 30 days after the date when a
17	settlement was paid, the Governor's Office of Administration
18	shall submit the information under paragraph (1) to the
19	chairperson and minority chairperson of the Appropriations
20	Committee of the Senate and the chairperson and minority
21	chairperson of the Appropriations Committee of the House of
22	<u>Representatives.</u>
23	(g) ExemptionNotwithstanding subsections (a), (b) [and],
24	(f) and (f.1), the following shall not be included on the
25	website:
26	(1) Records, data or other information exempted from
27	disclosure under 24 Pa.C.S. § 8502(e)(2) (relating to
28	administrative duties of board).
29	(2) Records, data or other information exempted from
30	disclosure under 71 Pa.C.S. § 5902(e)(2) (relating to
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1	administrative duties of the board).
2	(3) Records not subject to disclosure under the act of
3	February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), known as the Right-to-Know
4	Law.

6	Section 2. Section 4(a) of the act is amended by adding a
7	paragraph to read:
8	Section 4. Administration.
9	(a) Commonwealth agency requirementsEach Commonwealth
10	agency shall cooperate with the Governor's Office of
11	Administration. The following shall apply:

13	(3) Each Commonwealth agency shall provide the office
14	with information on each settlement paid for each claim
15	settled as required under section 3(f.1) before posting the
16	information on the website.
