- 6 "PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYE." THE TERM SHALL HAVE THE MEANING
- 7 GIVEN IN SECTION 1101.
- 8 "SCHOOL ENTITY." A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE UNIT, AREA
- 9 CAREER AND TECHNICAL SCHOOL, CHARTER SCHOOL, CYBER CHARTER
- 10 SCHOOL OR REGIONAL CHARTER SCHOOL.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
