- Amending Title 24 (Education) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
 Statutes, providing for suicide prevention in institutions of
 higher education.

- 7 <u>"Education enterprise." An educational activity in this</u> <-

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- 9 <u>(1) for which college credits or continuing education</u>
 10 <u>units are awarded, continuing professional education is</u>
 11 <u>offered or tuition or fees are charged or collected; and</u>
 12 <u>(2) that is sponsored by a corporation, entity or</u>

institution that is incorporated or authorized by other means

(relating to nonprofit corporations).

- 3 § 7103. Student mental health and suicide prevention plans.
- 4 (a) Plan required and minimum required contents.--Each
- 5 <u>institution of higher education shall MAY develop and implement</u> <--
- 6 <u>a plan to advise students and staff on mental health and suicide</u>
- 7 prevention programs available both on campus and off campus. The
- 8 mental health and suicide prevention plan shall SHOULD, at a <
- 9 <u>minimum, include:</u>
- (1) Contact information for national, State and local
- 11 <u>suicide prevention hotlines.</u>
- 12 (2) Crisis intervention services, which shall include
- 13 providing the address, telephone number or any other contact
- 14 <u>information of individuals with training and experience in</u>
- 15 mental health issues who focus on suicide prevention. An
- institution of higher education shall make individuals with
- 17 training and experience available on campus or remotely for
- 18 students 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
- 19 (3) Mental health services and access, which shall
- include providing the necessary information to access mental
- 21 health services, including, but not limited to, health
- 22 promotion and wellness, student health and counseling, crisis
- 23 <u>services, local mental health providers and mental health</u>
- 24 clinics.
- 25 (4) Multimedia access, which shall include mental health
- and suicide warning signs, services available to individuals
- 27 <u>at no cost and available mental health and suicide prevention</u>
- resources, which may include mobile applications.
- 29 (5) Student communication plans, which shall consist of
- 30 outreach plans regarding, at a minimum, mental health

- 1 services and suicide prevention.
- 2 (6) Postintervention plans, which shall include a
- 3 process to create a strategic plan to communicate effectively
- 4 with students, staff and parents after the loss of a student
- 5 <u>to suicide.</u>
- 6 (b) Public posting. -- An IF AN institution of higher <--
- 7 education ADOPTS A PLAN UNDER SUBSECTION (A), THE INSTITUTION OF <--
- 8 HIGHER EDUCATION shall post on the institution's publicly
- 9 accessible Internet website the following:
- 10 (1) The mental health and suicide prevention plan
- 11 <u>adopted by the institution of higher education.</u>
- 12 (2) Applicable free prevention materials or programs.
- (c) Information for students.--The IF AN INSTITUTION OF <--

- 16 (1) An THE institution of higher education shall provide <--

- 25 HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL REVIEW AND UPDATE THE PLAN AT LEAST ONCE
- 26 ANNUALLY.

- 29 (A) TRANSMITTAL OF PLAN. -- IF AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER

- 4 (B) DUTIES OF DEPARTMENT.--
- 5 (1) IF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION RECEIVES A STUDENT
- 6 MENTAL HEALTH AND SUICIDE PREVENTION PLAN FROM AN INSTITUTION
- 7 OF HIGHER EDUCATION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL POST THAT
- 8 <u>INFORMATION ON ITS PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE.</u>
- 9 (2) IF AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SUBMITS A PLAN
- 10 TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION CONTAINING INFORMATION UNDER

- 12 <u>DEPARTMENT SHALL DESIGNATE THE INSTITUTION OF HIGHER</u>
- 13 EDUCATION AS A CERTIFIED SUICIDE PREVENTION INSTITUTION OF
- 14 <u>HIGHER EDUCATION.</u>
- 15 (3) THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION MAY ADOPT OR CREATE A
- 16 LOGO FOR INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT HAVE BEEN
- 17 CERTIFIED AS CERTIFIED SUICIDE PREVENTION INSTITUTIONS OF
- 18 HIGHER EDUCATION. IF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION ADOPTS OR
- 19 CREATES A LOGO, AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION WHICH HAS
- 20 BEEN CERTIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION MAY USE THE
- 21 LOGO.
- 22 (C) DESIGNATION OF INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION.--UPON
- 23 LISTING OF AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION'S PLAN CONTAINING
- 24 INFORMATION UNDER SECTION 7103(A)(1), (2), (3), (4), (5) AND (6)
- 25 ON THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION'S PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET
- 26 WEBSITE, THE INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION MAY USE AND MARKET
- 27 THE DESIGNATION OF "CERTIFIED SUICIDE PREVENTION INSTITUTION OF
- 28 HIGHER EDUCATION."
- 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 120 days.
