AN ACT

Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in grants to fire companies and emergency medical services companies, further providing for award of grants and for expiration of authority. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Sections 7813(a) and 7823(a) of Title 35 of the 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended by adding paragraphs to read: 10 § 7813. Award of grants. 11 Authorization. -- The agency is authorized to make a grant 12 award to each eligible fire company for the following: * * * 13 14 (6) Recruitment and retention, including, but not 15 limited to, volunteer firefighter length of service award programs and programs for minors serving in volunteer 16 17 emergency service organizations.
