7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Section 701 of the act of November 10, 1999
10	(P.L.491, No.45), known as the Pennsylvania Construction Code
11	Act, is amended by adding a subsection to read:
12	Section 701. Training of inspectors.

14	(c.1) Inactive status of certification
15	(1) The department may by regulation establish a
16	procedure for a code administrator to request to have the
17	code administrator's certification under subsection (c)
18	maintained on inactive status.
19	(2) Reactivation of a certificate may occur upon the
20	passage of required examinations demonstrating knowledge of

1	the standards under Chapter 3, provided that reactivation may
2	not be granted if more than four years have passed since the
3	expiration of the certification.
4	(3) Requests to have a certification maintained in
5	inactive status shall be granted if the applicant
6	demonstrates just cause for requiring the inactive status.
7	(4) For the purposes of this subsection, the term "just
8	cause" means reasons for inactivity which include, but are
9	not be limited to, personal or family-related reasons or
10	temporary relocation outside of this Commonwealth.

12	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
