4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	<u>§ 7518. Failure to report death.</u>
9	(a) Offense definedExcept as provided in subsection (b),
10	a person is guilty of a summary offense if, upon witnessing the
11	death of an individual or discovering the body of an individual
12	the person knows or reasonably believes is dead, the person
13	fails to, in the most expeditious manner possible, notify a 911
14	system, physician or other medical professional, law enforcement
15	agency or funeral home.
16	(b) ExceptionSubsection (a) shall not apply:
17	(1) If the person knows or reasonably believes that a
18	911 system, physician or other medical professional, law

1	enforcement agency or funeral home has been notified of the
2	death of the individual or discovery of the body of the
3	individual.
4	(2) To the following:
5	(i) A child under 14 years of age.
6	(ii) An individual with an intellectual disability
7	acting under the direction of their parent, an individual
8	residing in the same household or an individual
9	responsible for their welfare.
10	(c) DefinitionAs used in this section, the term "funeral
11	home" shall have the same meaning as "funeral establishment" in
12	<u>section 2(6) of the act of January 14, 1952 (1951 P.L.1898,</u>
13	No.522), known as the Funeral Director Law.
14	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
