8	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding paragraphs to read:
9	§ 1329. Valuation of acquired water and wastewater systems.

11	(c) Ratemaking rate baseThe following apply:

13	(3) The depreciated original cost of the acquired system
14	as calculated under subsection (d)(5) may be incorporated <
15	into MAY BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ratemaking rate base as <
16	soon as the first base rate case post-closing or in the

2	(4) The difference between the depreciated original
3	cost calculated under subsection (d)(5) and the ratemaking <
4	rate base of the selling utility as determined under
5	paragraph (2) shall be incorporated into the rate base of the
6	acquiring public utility equally over the three base rate
7	cases after closing or in the entity's first three base rate
8	cases after its initial tariff filing.

10	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
