## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for Public Facilities
- 3 Infrastructure Grant Program.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 53 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:

- 17 § 6301. Definitions.

- 1 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 2 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 3 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 4 <u>"Department." The Department of Community and Economic</u>
- 5 <u>Development of the Commonwealth.</u>
- 6 "Eligible applicant." A municipality or local library.
- 7 <u>"Grant program." The Public Facilities Infrastructure Grant</u>
- 8 Program established under section 6302 (relating to grant
- 9 program).
- 10 "Local library." Any free, public, nonsectarian library,
- 11 whether established and maintained by a municipality or by a
- 12 private association, corporation or group, which serves the
- 13 <u>informational</u>, educational and recreational needs of all the
- 14 residents of the area for which the governing body is
- 15 responsible.
- 16 "Municipality." A county, city, borough, incorporated town
- 17 or township or home rule municipality.
- 18 "Public facility." A public building, structure, facility,
- 19 <u>land or waterway used for a recreational purpose</u>, including a
- 20 playground, swimming facility, athletic field, court,
- 21 maintenance building, recreational center or environmental
- 22 center.
- 23 § 6302. Grant program.
- 24 (a) Establishment.--The Public Facilities Infrastructure
- 25 Grant Program is established as a competitive grant program
- 26 within the department.
- 27 (b) Use of grants.--Money awarded under the grant program
- 28 shall be used for the maintenance, repair, renovation or
- 29 reconstruction of a building or public facility owned by a
- 30 municipality or local library.

- 1 (c) Department powers and duties. -- The department shall:
- 2 <u>(1) Within 180 days of the effective date of this</u>
- 3 paragraph, establish quidelines necessary to award grants
- 4 <u>under this chapter.</u>
- 5 (2) Award grants under the grant program in accordance
- 6 <u>with this chapter to eligible applicants for uses provided</u>
- 7 <u>under subsection (b).</u>
- 8 <u>(3) Determine the form and manner by which applicants</u>
- 9 <u>may apply for a grant under section 6306 (relating to</u>
- 10 administration) and post the information on the department's
- 11 publicly accessible Internet website.
- 12 (d) Compliance with Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act. -- The
- 13 maintenance, repair, renovation or reconstruction of a building
- 14 or public facility using money awarded under the grant program
- 15 shall be done in compliance with the act of August 15, 1961
- 16 (P.L.987, No.442), known as the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage
- 17 Act.
- 18 <u>§ 6303</u>. Funding.
- 19 The General Assembly shall appropriate money to the
- 20 department from the General Fund for the purpose of awarding
- 21 grants under this chapter.
- 22 <u>§ 6304</u>. Plan.
- 23 Within 90 days of the effective date of this section and each
- 24 March 15 thereafter, the department shall adopt a plan which
- 25 establishes the department's priorities for that year and
- 26 describes the method in which grant program money will be
- 27 <u>distributed that year.</u>
- 28 <u>§ 6305</u>. Reporting.
- 29 <u>The following apply:</u>
- 30 (1) Within 90 days of the close of the first calendar

- 1 year after the effective date of this paragraph and by each
- 2 <u>July 1 thereafter, the department shall issue a report</u>
- 3 containing a financial statement, an itemized list of
- 4 projects funded and a description of other expenditures in
- 5 <u>the preceding calendar year.</u>
- 6 (2) The report shall be submitted to the Governor, the
- Auditor General, the chair and minority chair of the Local
- 8 Government Committee of the Senate and the chair and minority
- 9 chair of the Local Government Committee of the House of
- 10 Representatives and published on the department's publicly
- 11 <u>accessible Internet website.</u>
- 12 <u>(3) The report shall be a public record.</u>
- 13 <u>§ 6306</u>. Administration.
- 14 (a) Applications. -- An application for a grant under this
- 15 chapter shall be submitted by an eligible applicant in the form
- 16 <u>and manner prescribed by the department.</u>
- 17 (b) Review process.--
- 18 (1) The department shall review applications and make
- 19 awards subject to subsection (c).
- 20 (2) The department shall consider the geographical
- 21 distribution of money to ensure that all areas of this
- 22 Commonwealth participate to the greatest extent possible.
- 23 (3) An eligible applicant may revise and resubmit a
- 24 <u>denied application to the department.</u>
- 25 <u>(c) Allocation. -- An eligible applicant may not receive more</u>
- 26 than \$750,000 in a fiscal year.
- 27 (d) Limitation. -- The department may only award a grant to an
- 28 eligible applicant that provides matching funds equal to at
- 29 least 50% of the amount awarded.
- 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
