- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in fees, further providing for exemption of 2 persons, entities and vehicles from fees. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 1901(c) introductory paragraph and (d)(2) 7 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended, subsection (c) is amended by adding a paragraph and the 8 section is amended by adding a subsection to read: 9 10 § 1901. Exemption of persons, entities and vehicles from fees. 11 (c) Processing fee in lieu of registration fee. -- No 12 13 registration fee shall be charged for vehicles registered by any 14 of the following but the department shall charge a fee of [\$10] 15 \$11 to cover the costs of processing for issuing or renewing the 16 registration:

- 4 (2) Only one passenger car or truck with a registered

- 9 <u>(f) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following</u>
- 10 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 11 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 "Nonprofit emergency medical services agency." An emergency
- 13 medical services agency as defined in 35 Pa.C.S. § 8103
- 14 <u>(relating to definitions) and chartered as a nonprofit</u>
- 15 <u>corporation within this Commonwealth.</u>
- 16 <u>"Volunteer." A member of a volunteer fire company or a</u>
- 17 nonprofit emergency medical services agency.
- 18 "Volunteer fire company." A nonprofit chartered corporation,
- 19 association or organization located in this Commonwealth that
- 20 provides fire protection services and may offer other voluntary
- 21 emergency services within this Commonwealth.
- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
