AN ACT

Amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), entitled "An act relating to alcoholic liquors, alcohol and malt and 2 brewed beverages; amending, revising, consolidating and 3 changing the laws relating thereto; regulating and restricting the manufacture, purchase, sale, possession, 5 consumption, importation, transportation, furnishing, holding 6 in bond, holding in storage, traffic in and use of alcoholic liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the 7 8 persons engaged or employed therein; defining the powers and 9 duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing 10 for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores, 11 for the payment of certain license fees to the respective 12 municipalities and townships, for the abatement of certain 13 nuisances and, in certain cases, for search and seizure 14 without warrant; prescribing penalties and forfeitures; 15 providing for local option, and repealing existing laws," in 16 disposition of moneys collected under provisions of act, 17 further providing for moneys paid into the State Stores Fund 18 for use of the Commonwealth. 19 20 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 21 hereby enacts as follows: 22 Section 1. Section 802(f) of the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), known as the Liquor Code, is amended and the 24 section is amended by adding subsections to read: 25 Section 802. Moneys Paid Into The State Stores Fund for Use

of the Commonwealth. -- * * *

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- 1 [(f) Any moneys in the State Stores Fund, from time to time,
- 2 which may not be required for any of the purposes specified in
- 3 this act or in the act of December 20, 1933 (Sp.Sess., P.L.89,
- 4 No.15), entitled "An act appropriating the moneys in The State
- 5 Stores Fund," shall be paid over into the General Fund and shall
- 6 be available for the payment of appropriations made from the
- 7 General Fund. The Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board, with the
- 8 approval of the Governor, shall, from time to time, fix the
- 9 amount of money which may be so paid over into the General Fund
- 10 and by its requisition shall direct the Department of the
- 11 Auditor General and the Treasury Department to transfer such
- 12 moneys from the State Stores Fund to the General Fund. The
- 13 Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board shall, immediately upon voting
- 14 to pay over any moneys from the State Stores Fund to the General
- 15 Fund, notify the chairman and minority chairman of the
- 16 Appropriations Committee of the Senate and the chairman and
- 17 minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the House
- 18 of Representatives of such transfer of moneys.]
- 19 (f.1) The Governor shall recommend an amount for transfer
- 20 from the State Stores Fund to the General Fund as part of the
- 21 budget submission required by section 613 of the act of April 9,
- 22 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as "The Administrative Code of
- 23 1929."
- 24 (f.2) An amount transferred from the State Stores Fund to
- 25 the General Fund in a General Appropriation Act or other act
- 26 shall be effectuated in at least two installments. No less than
- 27 <u>half the amount shall be transferred to the General Fund by</u>
- 28 December 31 during the fiscal year and the remaining amount
- 29 shall be transferred to the General Fund by the following June
- 30 15.

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- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020, or
- 3 immediately, whichever is later.
