## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, repealing provisions relating to uniformity
- of taxation.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 8 That section 1 of Article VIII be repealed:
- 9 [§ 1. Uniformity of taxation.
- All taxes shall be uniform, upon the same class of subjects,
- 11 within the territorial limits of the authority levying the tax,
- 12 and shall be levied and collected under general laws.]
- 13 Section 2. The following procedure applies to the proposed
- 14 constitutional amendment in this joint resolution:
- 15 (1) Upon the first passage by the General Assembly of
- 16 the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall

proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania.

Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of 4 the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall 5 6 proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution 7 of Pennsylvania. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall 8 submit the amendment to the qualified electors of this 9 Commonwealth at the first primary, general or municipal 10 election which meets the requirements of section 1 of Article 11 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania. 12
