1 2	Amending Title 58 (Oil and Gas) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in development, further providing for well permits.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Section 3211(b.1) of Title 58 of the Pennsylvania
6	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
7	§ 3211. Well permits.

9	(b.1) NotificationThe applicant shall submit proof of
10	notification with the well permit application. Notification of
11	surface owners shall be performed by sending notice to those
12	persons to whom the tax notices for the surface property are
13	sent, as indicated in the assessment books in the county in
14	which the property is located. Notification of surface
15	landowners or water purveyors shall be on forms, and in a manner
16	prescribed by the department, sufficient to identify the rights
17	afforded those persons under section 3218 (relating to

protection of water supplies) and to advise them of the advantages of taking their own predrilling or prealteration survey. The well operator shall give public notice of the filing by publication in a newspaper of general circulation, published in the locality where the permit is applied for, once a week for four consecutive weeks. * * * Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
