(3) Receive, from the Commonwealth or the Commonwealth's 4 instrumentalities, requests for approval for assistance by 5 the Civil Air Patrol in natural or man-made disasters or 6 emergency situations. A requested and approved mission must 7 be approved or denied in accordance with Federal procedures 8 9 and in consultation with the Adjutant General or the Adjutant General's designee and the Pennsylvania Emergency Management 10 11 Agency. (c) Construction. -- Nothing in this section shall be 12 13 construed to limit, diminish or impair an authority, right or 14 agreement validly established and existing on the effective date 15 of this section. (d) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following 16 17 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this 18 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise: 19 "Assistance."
