Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in child protective services, further 2 providing for release of information in confidential reports 3 and for exchange of information. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 6340(a)(13) of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 8 § 6340. Release of information in confidential reports. General rule. -- Reports specified in section 6339 10 11 (relating to confidentiality of reports) shall only be made 12 available to: * * * 1.3 14 (13) School administrators and child-care service 15 employers, as provided under this paragraph. The following 16 shall apply: 17 If the alleged perpetrator is a school employee or child-care service employee, school administrators and 18

- child-care service employers shall receive notice of a pending allegation and the final status of the report following the investigation as to whether the report is indicated, founded or unfounded.
 - (ii) Information disclosed pursuant to this paragraph shall be provided to the school administrator or child-care service employer within ten days of the completion of the investigation.
- 9 (iii) If the perpetrator is a school employee, the
 10 notice of the final status of the report shall be sent to
 11 the Department of Education within ten days of the
 12 completion of the investigation.
- (iv) If the alleged perpetrator is not a school

 employee, a school administrator shall receive

 information regarding a founded or indicated report made

 pursuant to this chapter for the sole purpose of

 effectuating section 6340.1(e) (relating to exchange of

 information).

9	subject of a founded or indicated report and when a student
10	is considered to be a previous subject of a founded or
11	indicated report.
12	(4) Maintain confidentiality during the sharing of
13	information between school administrators and the department
14	under this subsection.
15	Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
