AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 7, 1980 (P.L.380, No.97), entitled "An act providing for the planning and regulation of solid waste storage, collection, transportation, processing, treatment, 3 and disposal; requiring municipalities to submit plans for 4 municipal waste management systems in their jurisdictions; authorizing grants to municipalities; providing regulation of 6 the management of municipal, residual and hazardous waste; 7 requiring permits for operating hazardous waste and solid 8 waste storage, processing, treatment, and disposal 9 facilities; and licenses for transportation of hazardous 10 11 waste; imposing duties on persons and municipalities; granting powers to municipalities; authorizing the 12 Environmental Quality Board and the Department of 13 Environmental Resources to adopt rules, regulations, 14 standards and procedures; granting powers to and imposing 15 duties upon county health departments; providing remedies; prescribing penalties; and establishing a fund," in 16 17 applications and permits, providing for public comment and 18 19 for prohibitions. 20 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 21 hereby enacts as follows: 22 The act of July 7, 1980 (P.L.380, No.97), known Section 1. 23 as the Solid Waste Management Act, is amended by adding a 24 section to read: 25 Section 502.1. Public comment.
- 26 (a) Notwithstanding any other law, the department shall

- 1 conduct at least one public hearing for the purpose of receiving
- 2 <u>information at least 180 days prior to the application of sewage</u>
- 3 <u>sludge under a land reclamation permit for the surface land</u>
- 4 application of sewage sludge.
- 5 (b) At least 30 days prior to conducting a hearing under
- 6 subsection (a), the department must publish notice of the
- 7 <u>hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the affected</u>
- 8 area.
- 9 (c) When a public hearing is held, a person may testify
- 10 within the time provided or submit written comments, or both.
- 11 The department must consider testimony relevant to the
- 12 requirements of this act, the environmental protection acts and
- 13 <u>25 Pa. Code (relating to environmental protection).</u>
- 14 (d) After a hearing under subsection (c), the department
- 15 <u>must prepare a summary of the written and oral comments</u>
- 16 <u>submitted at the hearing, the department's responses to the</u>
- 17 comments and the reasons for the responses. The department must
- 18 provide copies of the summary to each person who submitted
- 19 comments and to other people who request a copy.
- (e) For the purposes of this section, the term
- 21 "environmental protection acts" shall include the following:
- 22 (1) The act of June 22, 1937 (P.L.1987, No.394), known
- 23 <u>as "The Clean Streams Law."</u>
- 24 (2) The act of May 31, 1945 (P.L.1198, No.418), known as
- 25 <u>the "Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act."</u>
- 26 (3) The act of January 8, 1960 (1959 P.L.2119, No.787),
- 27 known as the "Air Pollution Control Act."
- 28 (4) The act of November 26, 1978 (P.L.1375, No.325),
- 29 known as the "Dam Safety and Encroachments Act."
- 30 <u>(5) The act of December 19, 1984 (P.L.1093, No.219),</u>

- 1 <u>known as the "Noncoal Surface Mining Conservation and</u>
- 2 Reclamation Act."
- 3 (6) The act of February 9, 1988 (P.L.31, No.12), known
- 4 <u>as the "Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Act."</u>
- 5 (7) The act of July 13, 1988 (P.L.525, No.93), referred
- to as the Infectious and Chemotherapeutic Waste Law.
- 7 (8) The act of July 28, 1988 (P.L.556, No.101), known as
- 8 the "Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction
- 9 Act."
- 10 (9) The act of October 18, 1988 (P.L.756, No.108), known
- 11 as the "Hazardous Sites Cleanup Act."
- 12 (10) The act of May 19, 1995 (P.L.4, No.2), known as the
- "Land Recycling and Environmental Remediation Standards Act."
- 14 (11) Other Federal or State statutes relating to
- 15 <u>environmental protection or the protection of public health.</u>
- 16 Section 2. The act is amended by adding an article to read:
- 17 ARTICLE V-A
- 18 PROHIBITIONS
- 19 Section 501-A. Sewage sludge.
- Notwithstanding any other law, the application of sewage
- 21 sludge in a source water protection area under a land
- 22 reclamation permit for the surface land application of sewage
- 23 sludge is prohibited.
- 24 Section 3. All regulations and parts of regulations which
- 25 are inconsistent with the addition of section 502.1 of the act
- 26 are abrogated.
- 27 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
