## AN ACT

- 2 § 9701. Definitions.
- 3 The following words and phrases when used in this subchapter
- 4 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 5 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 6 <u>"Department." The Department of Transportation of the</u>
- 7 Commonwealth.
- 8 "Design-build contract." A contract in which the contractor
- 9 <u>is responsible for both the design and the construction</u>,
- 10 reconstruction, widening, repair or improvement of a highway
- 11 project.
- 12 "Highway project." The construction, reconstruction,
- 13 widening, repair or improvement of a State highway or a part of
- 14 a State highway.
- 15 "Program." The Highway Design-Build Program established by
- 16 <u>this subchapter.</u>
- 17 § 9702. Highway Design-Build Program.
- 18 (a) Establishment. -- The Highway Design-Build Program is
- 19 established within the department.
- 20 (b) Purpose. -- The purpose of the program is to save costs
- 21 and time by allowing the department to enter into design-build
- 22 contracts.
- 23 (c) Implementation. -- The department shall implement the
- 24 program as follows:
- 25 (1) The department shall annually develop a list of all
- highway projects that, in the department's discretion, are
- 27 <u>suitable for a design-build contract. When determining</u>
- 28 eligibility for a highway project for inclusion on the list,
- 29 the department shall analyze all highway projects which have
- a total projected cost of at least \$100,000,000.

- 1 (2) The department shall develop a process for the
- 2 solicitation of bids, requests for proposals and awarding of
- 3 <u>design-build contracts for highway projects contained in the</u>
- 4 <u>list required under paragraph (1).</u>
- 5 <u>(3) The department shall have the sole discretion to</u>
- 6 <u>accept and award design-build contracts under the program.</u>
- 7 (4) No more than 25% of the aggregate dollar amount of
- 8 <u>the department's highway projects in any fiscal year may be</u>
- 9 <u>completed through a design-build contract under the program.</u>
- 10 (d) Applicability. -- The provisions of 62 Pa.C.S. § 511
- 11 (relating to methods of source selection) shall not apply to the
- 12 program.
- 13 § 9703. Regulations.
- 14 <u>(a) General rule.--In order to facilitate the implementation</u>
- 15 of this subchapter, the department may promulgate regulations or
- 16 publish guidelines to implement any provision which is required
- 17 under this subchapter or which the department determines are
- 18 appropriate for implementation of this subchapter.
- 19 (b) Temporary regulations. -- Notwithstanding any other
- 20 provision of law, any regulation promulgated by the department
- 21 under this subchapter during the two years following the
- 22 effective date of this section shall be deemed temporary
- 23 <u>regulations which shall expire no later than three years</u>
- 24 following the effective date of this section or upon
- 25 promulgation of final regulations. The temporary regulations
- 26 shall not be subject to any of the following:
- 27 <u>(1) Sections 201, 202, 203 and 204 of the act of July</u>
- 28 31, 1968 (P.L.769, No.240), referred to as the Commonwealth
- 29 Documents Law.
- 30 (2) The act of June 25, 1982 (P.L.633, No.181), known as
