AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in preliminary provisions, providing
- for Deaf Education Commission.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 122.1. Deaf Education Commission.--(a) There is </u>
- 13 <u>hereby established the Deaf Education Commission in the</u>
- 14 Department of Education for the purpose of making
- 15 <u>recommendations on issues relating to the early linguistic</u>
- 16 <u>development of children who are deaf or hard of hearing as</u>
- 17 provided under this section.
- 18 (b) (1) The commission shall consist of the following

- 1 members appointed by the Secretary of Education:
- 2 (i) A parent of a child who is deaf or hard of hearing and
- 3 who uses the dual languages of American Sign Language and
- 4 English.
- 5 (ii) A parent of a child who is deaf or hard of hearing and
- 6 who uses only American Sign Language.
- 7 (iii) A parent of a child who is deaf or hard of hearing who
- 8 <u>uses only Listening and Spoken Language.</u>
- 9 (iv) A certified teacher of deaf or hard of hearing students
- 10 who uses the dual languages of American Sign Language and
- 11 <u>Listening and Spoken Language.</u>
- 12 (v) A certified teacher of deaf or hard of hearing students
- 13 <u>employed at a Department of Education-approved school for</u>
- 14 special education which serves deaf or hard of hearing students.
- 15 (vi) An expert with a master's or doctorate degree who
- 16 <u>researches language outcomes for deaf or hard of hearing</u>
- 17 children using American Sign Language and English.
- 18 (vii) An expert with a master's or doctorate degree who
- 19 <u>researches language outcomes for deaf or hard of hearing</u>
- 20 children using Listening and Spoken Language.
- 21 (viii) An expert with a master's or doctorate degree who
- 22 researches language outcomes for deaf or hard of hearing
- 23 <u>children using only American Sign Language.</u>
- 24 (ix) A certified teacher of deaf or hard of hearing students
- 25 whose expertise is in curriculum and instruction in American
- 26 Sign Language and English.
- 27 (x) An advocate for the teaching and use of the dual
- 28 languages of American Sign Language and English;
- 29 (xi) An advocate for the teaching and use of Listening and
- 30 Spoken Language.

- 1 (xii) An early intervention specialist who is certified or
- 2 <u>licensed to work with deaf or hard of hearing infants and</u>
- 3 toddlers using the dual languages of American Sign Language and
- 4 English.
- 5 (xiii) A certified teacher of deaf or hard of hearing
- 6 <u>students whose expertise is in American Sign Language and</u>
- 7 English language assessment.
- 8 (xiv) A speech-language pathologist with expertise in
- 9 <u>Listening and Spoken Language for children who are deaf or hard</u>
- 10 of hearing.
- 11 (xv) A school administrator for American Sign Language-based
- 12 education.
- 13 (xvi) A school administrator for Listening and Spoken
- 14 <u>Language-based education</u>.
- 15 (xvii) A student who identifies as deaf or hard of hearing.
- 16 (2) The Secretary of Education shall make the appointments
- 17 to the commission under paragraph (1) within thirty (30) days
- 18 after the effective date of this section. Vacancies in the
- 19 membership of the commission shall be filled in the same manner
- 20 as the original appointments were made.
- 21 (c) (1) The commission shall examine, research and issue
- 22 recommendations to the Department of Education and the
- 23 Department of Human Services for all of the following:
- 24 (i) The development of a resource guide for a parent or
- 25 quardian of a deaf or hard of hearing child to monitor and track
- 26 the child's expressive and receptive language acquisition and
- 27 <u>developmental stages toward English literacy as required under</u>
- 28 subsection (d)(1).
- 29 (ii) Potential improvements to early intervention programs
- 30 available to deaf or hard of hearing students for the purpose

- 1 <u>specified under subsection (e).</u>
- 2 (iii) The development of methods of evaluation to annually
- 3 collect and publicly report data on language acquisition and
- 4 <u>developmental progress of children who are deaf or hard of</u>
- 5 hearing from birth to five (5) years of age for the purpose
- 6 <u>specified under subsection (f).</u>
- 7 (2) The commission shall issue the recommendations under
- 8 paragraph (1) no later than one (1) year after the commission
- 9 organizes. The commission shall transmit a notice to the
- 10 Legislative Reference Bureau upon issuing the recommendations
- 11 under paragraph (1) for publication in the Pennsylvania
- 12 <u>Bulletin</u>.
- 13 (d) (1) The Department of Education, in an effort to assist
- 14 <u>deaf or hard of hearing children in becoming linguistically</u>
- 15 ready for kindergarten and in consultation with the Department
- 16 of Human Services, shall develop a resource guide for use by a
- 17 parent or quardian of a deaf or hard of hearing child.
- 18 The resource guide shall:
- 19 (i) Help a parent or quardian of a deaf or hard of hearing
- 20 child monitor and track the child's expressive and receptive
- 21 <u>language acquisition and developmental stages toward English</u>
- 22 literacy by presenting language developmental milestones.
- 23 (ii) Be appropriate for use regarding content and
- 24 administration for a deaf or hard of hearing child from birth to
- 25 five (5) years of age who uses American Sign Language or
- 26 English.
- 27 (iii) Be written for clarity and ease of use by a parent or
- 28 guardian of a deaf or hard of hearing child.
- 29 (iv) Be aligned to existing instruments used by school
- 30 entities to assess the development of a child with disabilities

- 1 in accordance with Federal and State law.
- 2 (v) Include a statement that the resource guide is not a
- 3 formal assessment of language and literacy development and the
- 4 <u>observations of a parent or guardian of a deaf or hard of</u>
- 5 <u>hearing child may differ from formal assessment data collected</u>
- 6 <u>as part of a professional evaluation.</u>
- 7 (vi) Include a statement that a parent or quardian of a deaf
- 8 or hard of hearing child may bring the resource guide to a child
- 9 study team meeting for the purpose of sharing observations about
- 10 the child's development.
- 11 (2) The Department of Education shall incorporate the
- 12 <u>recommendations issued by the commission under subsection (c)(1)</u>
- 13 <u>into the resource guide.</u>
- 14 (3) The Department of Education shall make the resource
- 15 guide available on the Department of Education's publicly
- 16 accessible Internet website.
- 17 (e) After consideration of the recommendations issued under
- 18 subsection (c)(1), the Department of Education, in consultation
- 19 with the Department of Human Services, shall make improvements
- 20 to the early intervention programs available to deaf or hard of
- 21 hearing students.
- 22 (f) The Department of Education and the Department of Human
- 23 Services shall implement the methods developed by the commission
- 24 under subsection (c)(1)(iii) to annually collect and publicly
- 25 report data on the language acquisition and developmental
- 26 progress of children from birth to five (5) years of age who are
- 27 <u>deaf or hard of hearing.</u>
- 28 (q) The commission shall expire thirty (30) days after the
- 29 <u>date the notice is published under subsection (c)(2).</u>
- 30 (h) As used in this section, the term "commission" shall

- 1 mean the Deaf Education Commission established under this
- 2 <u>section</u>.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
