AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 1, 1974 (P.L.90, No.24), entitled "An
2 act relating to the labeling, distribution, storage,
3 transportation, use, application and disposal of pesticides
4 and devices; providing for registration and examination of
5 such materials; the licensing of pesticide dealers and pest
6 management consultants and imposing penalties," providing for
7 prohibited pesticides.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. The act of March 1, 1974 (P.L.90, No.24), known
11 as the Pennsylvania Pesticide Control Act of 1973, is amended
12 by adding a section to read:

13 Section 27.1. Prohibited Pesticides.--(a) Use of the
14 following pesticides shall be prohibited in this Commonwealth:

15 (1) Chlorpyrifos.

16 (2) (Reserved).

17 (b) As used in this section, the term "chlorpyrifos" means
18 an organophosphate insecticide, acaricide and miticide used
19 primarily to control foliage and soil-borne insect pests on a

1 variety of animals, buildings, food, feed crops and other
2 settings.

3 Section 2. All regulations are abrogated to the extent of
4 any inconsistency with the provisions of this act.

5 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
