## AN ACT

Amending Title 3 (Agriculture) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in food protection, further providing for 2 misbranding of food. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 5729(a)(10) of Title 3 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 7 8 § 5729. Misbranding of food. 9 General rule. -- A food shall be misbranded: 10 (10) If it is a raw agricultural commodity bearing or 11 containing a pesticide chemical applied after harvest, unless 12 13 the shipping container of the commodity bears labeling which 14 clearly and conspicuously declares the presence of the 15 chemical and the common or usual name and function of the 16 chemical. A clear and conspicuous declaration shall [not] be

required when the commodity is removed from the shipping

- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 270 days.
