Female mutilation. 14 * * * (d.1) Revocation of licenses. -- A physician who is convicted 15 of an offense under subsection (a) shall, in addition to the 16 17 penalty prescribed under this section, be subject to revocation 18 of the physician's license in accordance with the Osteopathic 19 Medical Practice Act or the Medical Practice Act of 1985, as 20 applicable. (d.2) Public education and outreach. -- The Attorney General, 21
