- Amending the act of May 26, 2017 (P.L.6, No.3), entitled "An act providing for participation in the REAL ID Act of 2005, for
- compliance by residents of this Commonwealth, for reports to
- General Assembly and for publication; and repealing the REAL
- 5 ID Nonparticipation Act, providing for exemption from fees.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. The act of May 26, 2017 (P.L.6, No.3), known as
- 9 the Pennsylvania REAL ID Compliance Act, is amended by adding a
- 10 section to read:
- 11 <u>Section 3.1. Exemption from fees.</u>
- 12 (a) General rule. -- An eliquible applicant who is at least 65
- 13 years of age shall be exempt from all fees related to the
- 14 administration of this act and may only be required to pay the
- 15 costs of a standard-issued driver's license or photo
- 16 identification card.
- 17 (b) Fees.--The department shall establish reasonable and

- 1 appropriate fees in order to administer this section.
- 2 Section 2. Any regulations inconsistent with this act are
- 3 abrogated to the extent of any inconsistency with this act.
- 4 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
