- 1 (c) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "active
- 2 <u>military duty" shall include active service in any of the armed</u>
- 3 forces of the United States, including a National Guard or
- 4 <u>reserve component.</u>
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
