AN ACT

- 1 Providing for records notification service.
- 2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 3 hereby enacts as follows:
- 4 Section 1. Short title.
- 5 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Records
- 6 Notification Service Act.
- 7 Section 2. Definitions.
- 8 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 9 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 10 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Recorder." As follows:
- 12 (1) A county recorder of deeds or a county official or
- department responsible for the recording of documents in a
- 14 county without a recorder of deeds.
- 15 (2) The term includes the Philadelphia Department of
- 16 Records and the Allegheny County Department of Real Estate.
- 17 "Records notification service." The records notification

- 1 service established under section 3(a).
- 2 Section 3. Records notification service.
- 3 (a) Establishment, maintenance and purpose. -- Each recorder
- 4 shall establish and maintain a free records notification service
- 5 to alert a landowner of any recording tending to affect a right,
- 6 title or interest in the real property of the landowner.
- 7 (b) Duties.--Each recorder that establishes and maintains a
- 8 records notification service shall:
- 9 (1) Ensure that the records notification service is
- 10 capable of notifying a landowner by text or email within 24
- 11 hours of any recording tending to affect a right, title or
- 12 interest in the real property of the landowner.
- 13 (2) Allow a homeowner to register for the recording
- 14 notification service.
- 15 Section 4. Construction.
- Nothing in this act shall be construed to require a recorder
- 17 to provide or allow access to a record or information that is
- 18 confidential or exempt under law.
- 19 Section 5. Immunity.
- 20 A recorder shall not be subject to a cause of action or civil
- 21 liability regarding the creation, maintenance or operation of a
- 22 records notification service.
- 23 Section 6. Effective date.
- 24 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
