AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An
- act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public
- welfare laws of the Commonwealth," in public assistance,
- 4 further providing for workfare program.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 405.2 of the act of June 13, 1967
- 8 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, is amended by
- 9 adding a subsection to read:
- 10 Section 405.2. Workfare Program. --* * *
- 11 (a.1) Within six months of the effective date of this
- 12 <u>section</u>, the department shall establish a workfare pilot program
- 13 <u>in a county of the third class with a population between three</u>
- 14 hundred fifteen thousand (315,000) and three hundred forty
- 15 thousand (340,000) as of the latest Federal decennial census in
- 16 <u>accordance with the following:</u>
- 17 (1) An individual receiving cash assistance under Temporary
- 18 Assistance for Needy Families may receive benefits while working

- 1 for an employer for a forty-hour work week and receiving pay
- 2 <u>equivalent to twenty hours of work.</u>
- 3 (2) After the individual has worked for the employer for six
- 4 months, the individual may continue to receive cash assistance
- 5 and shall be paid for thirty hours for working a forty-hour work
- 6 <u>week.</u>
- 7 (3) After the individual has worked for the employer for
- 8 <u>twelve months</u>, the individual shall be paid for a full forty
- 9 hours of work for working a forty-hour work week, and the
- 10 department shall terminate the cash assistance payments to the
- 11 individual.
- 12 (4) Each other applicable provision of this section shall
- 13 apply to the workfare pilot program.

- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
