A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing separate and distinct amendments to the Constitution
- of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, providing for an
- 3 economic bill of rights.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following separate and distinct amendments to
- 7 the Constitution of Pennsylvania are proposed in accordance with
- 8 Article XI:
- 9 That Article I be amended by adding the following section to
- 10 read:
- 11 § 29. Economic bill of rights.
- 12 (a) The people shall have the right to a living wage to
- 13 <u>reasonably support one's self and their family.</u>
- 14 (b) The people shall have the right to affordable and
- 15 accessible health care and the opportunity to achieve and enjoy
- 16 good physical and mental health.
- 17 (c) The people shall have the right to safe, efficient and

- 1 <u>reliable transportation infrastructure.</u>
- 2 (d) The people shall have the right to safe and healthy
- 3 working conditions.
- 4 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General
- 5 Assembly of these proposed separate and distinct constitutional
- 6 amendments, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed
- 7 immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of
- 8 section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and
- 9 shall transmit the required advertisements to two newspapers in
- 10 every county in which such newspapers are published in
- 11 sufficient time after passage of these proposed constitutional
- 12 amendments.
- 13 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of these
- 14 proposed separate and distinct constitutional amendments, the
- 15 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to
- 16 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article
- 17 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the
- 18 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in
- 19 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after
- 20 passage of these proposed constitutional amendments. The
- 21 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall submit the proposed separate
- 22 and distinct constitutional amendments under section 1 of this
- 23 resolution to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth as
- 24 four separate and distinct ballot questions at the first
- 25 primary, general or municipal election which meets the
- 26 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article
- 27 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least
- 28 three months after the proposed constitutional amendments are
- 29 passed by the General Assembly.
