14	(27) A teaching staff member, a school board member or
15	other employee, including a student employee, of any
16	elementary or secondary publicly funded educational
17	institution, any elementary or secondary private school
18	licensed by the Department of Education or any elementary or

1	secondary parochial school while acting in the scope of his
2	or her employment or because of his or her employment
3	relationship to the school. This paragraph includes a school
4	crossing guard of a school district or local police
5	department, while acting in the scope of his or her
6	employment or because of his or her employment relationship
7	to the school.

9	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
