## AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in licensing of drivers, providing for private 1 2 driver education and training schools; and making a related 3 repeal. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 1508.2. Private driver education and training schools. 10 (a) General rule. -- The department shall establish: 11 (1) A program to license or permit private driver education schools and driver education instructors. 12 13 (2) The minimum standards for a driver education 14 curriculum. 15 (b) Applicability. -- Unless the person has been licensed or 16 permitted by the department in accordance with subsection (a), 17 no person shall operate as a: (1) Private driver education school. 18

1	(2) Driver education instructor.
2	(c) Driver education curriculum and testing The department
3	shall develop the driver education curriculum and standards for
4	testing of driver education instructors, which may include, but
5	shall not be limited to, provision for the following:
6	(1) An abbreviated license process for applicants who
7	previously have been licensed under the act of January 18,
8	1952 (1951 P.L.2128, No.605), referred to as the Private
9	Driver Education or Training School Act.
10	(2) An abbreviated license process for licensure as a
11	private driver education school or as a driver education
12	instructor for applicants that have been authorized to
13	administer third-party drivers' licensing exams, as permitted
14	by section 1508.1 (relating to physical examinations).
15	(3) Multiple driver education instructor testing
16	locations that strategically include all regions of this
17	Commonwealth. At no point shall there be only one instructor
18	testing location within this Commonwealth.
19	(4) The development of an electronic version of the
20	examination required for licensure as a driver education
21	instructor.
22	(5) Prohibiting a driver education instructor from
23	administering a third-party drivers' licensing exam, as
24	permitted by section 1508.1, and the driver education
25	curriculum to the same prospective licensed driver.
26	(6) Requiring an applicant for licensure as a driver

- education instructor to complete a private driver education 27 28 school's training program before obtaining a department-
- 29 issued license.
- 30 (7) Requiring a driver education instructor to pass a

- 1 physical driving examination to obtain a department-issued
- 2 license when the individual has an excess number of points
- 3 under section 1535 (relating to schedule of convictions and
- 4 <u>points).</u>
- 5 (d) Penalty. -- Any person violating subsection (b) commits a
- 6 <u>summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay</u>
- 7 a fine of \$500.
- 8 (e) Applicability. -- This section shall not apply to colleges
- 9 <u>or universities</u>, schools maintained or classes conducted by
- 10 employers for their own employees where no fee or tuition is
- 11 charged, schools or classes owned and operated by or under the
- 12 <u>authority of bona fide religious institutions</u>, or by the
- 13 Commonwealth or a political subdivision of the Commonwealth, or
- 14 schools accredited by accrediting associations approved by the
- 15 Department of Education or schools licensed by the State Board
- 16 of Private Academic Schools.
- 17 (f) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 18 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 19 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 20 "Department-issued license." A verifiable document issued to
- 21 a private driver education school or driver education instructor
- 22 stating the department has certified the eligibility of the
- 23 private driver education school or driver education instructor
- 24 to administer the driver education curriculum to a prospective
- 25 licensed driver.
- 26 "Driver education curriculum." A practical or theoretical
- 27 <u>experience needed to teach the knowledge how to operate a motor</u>
- 28 vehicle on a roadway requiring the motorist to navigate through
- 29 <u>traffic or a trafficway.</u>
- 30 "Driver education instructor." A person employed by or

- 1 <u>volunteering for a private driver education school and is tasked</u>
- 2 with teaching a prospective licensed driver how to lawfully,
- 3 safely and properly operate a motor vehicle.
- 4 <u>"Private driver education school." A person that administers</u>
- 5 schooling or training on how to operate a motor vehicle to a
- 6 prospective licensed driver by the Commonwealth for profit.
- 7 <u>"Prospective licensed driver." An individual who employs the</u>
- 8 services of a private driver education school for the purposes
- 9 of learning to operate a motor vehicle.
- 10 Section 2. Repeals are as follows:
- 11 (1) The General Assembly declares that the repeal under
- paragraph (2) is necessary to effectuate the addition of 75
- 13 Pa.C.S. § 1508.2.
- 14 (2) The act of January 18, 1952 (1951 P.L.2128, No.605),
- 15 referred to as the Private Driver Education or Training
- 16 School Act, is repealed.
- 17 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
