AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in fees, providing for exemption of active
- 3 volunteer first responders from fees.

- 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 1901.1. Exemption of active volunteer first responders from
- 9 <u>fees.</u>
- 10 (a) General rule. -- No fees shall be charged under sections
- 11 1305 (relating to application for registration) and 1309
- 12 (relating to renewal of registration) to an active volunteer
- 13 <u>first responder certified under subsection (b) for a vehicle</u>
- 14 owned by the active volunteer first responder to respond to
- 15 emergencies.
- 16 (b) Certification.--To receive an exemption under subsection

- 4 (1) An applicant for certification as an active first
 5 responder shall submit a signed application to the executive
 6 officer.
- 7 (2) The executive officer and another officer of the 8 first response organization shall:
- 9 <u>(i) Sign the application attesting to the</u>

 10 <u>individual's status as an active first responder.</u>
- (ii) Forward the application to the department for final review and approval.
- 13 <u>(iii) Submit vehicle information for the vehicle</u>
 14 <u>used by the active first responder to respond to</u>
 15 emergencies.
- 16 <u>(3) The department shall consider the following factors:</u>
- 17 <u>(i) The number of emergency calls to which a</u>

- (ii) The level of training and participation in formal training and drills of a volunteer.

- 5 "Active first responder." A member of a first response

- 7 "Emergency medical services agency." As defined in 35
- 8 Pa.C.S. § 8103 (relating to definitions).
- 9 "Executive officer." The chief or president of the first
- 10 response organization that a qualified applicant serves.
- 11 <u>"First response organization."</u> Any of the following:
- 12 <u>(1) An emergency medical services agency.</u>
- 13 <u>(2) A volunteer fire company.</u>
- 14 (3) A volunteer rescue company.
- 15 "Volunteer fire company." As defined in 35 Pa.C.S. § 7802
- 16 <u>(relating to definitions).</u>
- 17 <u>"Volunteer rescue company."</u> As defined in 35 Pa.C.S. § 7802.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
