## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in licensing of drivers, further providing for issuance and content of driver's license.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 1510 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding subsections to read:
8	§ 1510. Issuance and content of driver's license.

10	(k) Foster youth and homeless youthWhen a foster youth or
11	homeless youth applies for a driver's license or an
12	identification card:
13	(1) The department shall exempt the foster youth or
14	homeless youth from the payment of the fee for issuing the
15	driver's license or identification card.
16	(2) The department may issue the driver's license or
17	identification card without the signature or presence of or

1	permission from a parent or guardian.
2	(3) If the foster youth or homeless youth does not have
3	a residence or domicile, the department shall accept:
4	(i) a letter certifying that the individual is
5	homeless that is issued by the school district in which
6	the individual is enrolled, the director of an emergency
7	shelter or transition housing program or the director of
8	a basic center for runaway and homeless youth or a
9	transitional living program; or
10	(ii) the address of the office where a caseworker
11	for the individual is based if the individual is in
12	<u>foster care.</u>
13	(1) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
14	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
15	subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
16	"Foster youth." An individual under 18 years of age, or if a
17	<u>court retains dependency jurisdiction under 42 Pa.C.S. § 6351(j)</u>
18	(relating to disposition of dependent child), an individual up
19	to 21 years of age who is:
20	(1) under the care and responsibility of the
21	Commonwealth and is placed in foster care, as defined in 45
22	CFR 1355.20 (relating to definitions), under 42 Pa.C.S. §
23	6351 or 6352 (relating to disposition of delinquent child);
24	or
25	(2) placed under a voluntary placement agreement under
26	55 Pa. Code § 3130.65 (relating to voluntary placement
27	agreement).
28	"Homeless youth." The term shall have the same meaning as
29	"unaccompanied youth" under the McKinney-Vento Homeless
30	<u>Assistance Act (Public Law 100-77, 101 Stat. 482).</u>
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1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
