AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 1 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 3 Executive Department thereof and the administrative 4 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 5 6 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 8 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 12 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 17 and commissions; providing for judicial administration; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation 18 19 of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and commissions shall be 20 determined," in powers and duties of the Governor and other 21 22 constitutional officers, of the Executive Board and of the 23 Pennsylvania State Police, further providing for Pennsylvania State Police Force; in powers and duties of Department of 24 Conservation and Natural Resources, providing for Project 70; 25 in powers and duties of the Department of General Services 26 and its departmental administrative and advisory boards and 27 commissions, further providing for Department of 28 29 Environmental Resources powers not affected; in powers and 30 duties of the Department of Community Affairs, its departmental boards, bureaus and agencies, further providing 31 32 for powers and duties in general; and making a related 33 repeal.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 hereby enacts as follows:

3 Section 1. Section 712(b)(1) and (3) of the act of April 9, 4 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 5 1929, are amended to read:

6 Section 712. The Pennsylvania State Police Force.--The 7 various members of the Pennsylvania State Police are hereby 8 authorized and empowered:

9 * * *

10 (b) To act as game protectors, and as forest, fish, or fire 11 wardens, and for the better performance of such duties,

12 Seize all guns, boats, decoys, traps, dogs, game, fish, (1)13 shooting paraphernalia, or hunting or fishing appliances or 14 devices, used, taken, or had in possession, contrary to the laws 15 of this State. Any article so seized shall be held subject to 16 such disposition as the Executive Director of the Pennsylvania Fish Commission [or], the Executive Director of the Pennsylvania 17 18 Game Commission or the Secretary of [Environmental] Conservation_ 19 and Natural Resources may respectively determine.

(3) Search without warrant any boat, conveyance, vehicle or receptacle, when there is good reason to believe that any law has been violated, the enforcement or administration of which is imposed on or vested in the Pennsylvania Fish Commission or the Pennsylvania Game Commission or in the Department of

28 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
29 <u>Section 1903-B. Project 70.</u>

30 The Department of Conservation and Natural Resources shall

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have the powers and duties vested in the Department of Commerce 1 by the act of June 22, 1964 (Sp.Sess., P.L.131, No.8), known as 2 3 the Project 70 Land Acquisition and Borrowing Act. Section 3. Sections 2401.2 and 2501-C(h) of the act are 4 amended to read: 5 Section 2401.2. Department of [Environmental] Conservation 6 7 and Natural Resources Powers not Affected. -- It is not the 8 intention or purpose of this Article XXIV to curtail the historical construction activities of the Department of 9 10 Environmental Resources. Therefore, nothing in this article shall be interpreted as altering in any way the powers, duties 11 and authority of the Department of Environmental Resources as 12 13 possessed by it just prior to the effective date of this article[.] and transferred to the Department of Conservation and 14 Natural Resources by section 304 of the act of June 28, 1995 15 (P.L.89, No.18), known as the Conservation and Natural Resources 16 17 Act. 18 Section 2501-C. Powers and Duties in General.--The 19 Department of Community Affairs shall have the power, and its 20 duties shall be: * * * 21 (h) To coordinate and wherever provided by law to supervise 22 23 or administer the various programs of State and Federal 24 assistance and grants, including but not limited to housing, 25 redevelopment, urban renewal, urban planning assistance,

26 [Project 70,] area development, revitalization of central city 27 cores, mass transportation, river basin studies, port 28 development, air and water pollution, land and soil 29 conservation, economic opportunity, and public works and

30 community facilities and Appalachian assistance; and to furnish

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comprehensive planning and technical assistance on any program
 set forth in this subsection [(h)].

4 Section 4. Repeals are as follows:

5 (1) The General Assembly declares that the repeal under 6 paragraph (2) is necessary to effectuate the amendment of 7 section 712 of the act.

8 (2) Section 302(h) of the act of June 28, 1995 (P.L.89, 9 No.18), known as the Conservation and Natural Resources Act, 10 is repealed insofar as it relates to the administration of 11 section 712 of the act.

12 (3) The General Assembly declares that the repeal under 13 paragraph (4) is necessary to effectuate the addition of 14 section 1903-B and the amendment of section 2501-C(h) of the 15 act.

16 (4) Section 306(d) of the Conservation and Natural
17 Resources Act, is repealed insofar as it relates to the
18 transfer of duties from the Department of Community Affairs
19 to the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.
20 Section 5. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
