## AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 3 Executive Department thereof and the administrative 4 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 5 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 8 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 12 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 17 and commissions; providing for judicial administration; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation 18 of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of 19 certain departments, boards and commissions shall be 20

- 4 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known

- 12 19 Business Closure Order to all public and private construction
- 13 <u>activities that can adhere to the social distancing practices</u>
- 14 and other mitigation measures defined by the Centers for Disease
- 15 Control to protect workers and to mitigate the spread of the
- 16 COVID-19 virus.
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
